Our Commitment to Health, Safety and the Environment

As a Lower-Tier chemical warehouse operating under the UK's Control of Major Accident Hazards (COMAH) Regulations, we recognise our responsibility to manage hazardous substances with the highest regard for safety, compliance, and environmental protection.

Ensuring all chemicals are stored, handled, and transported in line with UK safety regulations.
Working transparently with our supply chain partners to reduce risks and encourage safe working practices.

Safety Measures in Our Operations

To maintain a safe working environment and fulfil our legal obligations under the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974, COSHH Regulations, and COMAH Regulations (2015), we have implemented the following controls:

Chemical Storage & Handling

All hazardous materials are stored with proper containment, segregation, and labelling.
Safety Data Sheets (SDS) are maintained for all products and available upon request.
Our staff are trained in the safe handling, transfer, and disposal of chemicals.

Risk Management

Risk assessments are regularly conducted and reviewed for all relevant warehouse operations.
Emergency response procedures are in place covering spills, fires, and medical incidents.
Fire detection, spill containment kits, and PPE are available and maintained at all times.

Contractor and Visitor Safety

All visitors and third-party contractors are required to comply with our site safety rules and may receive a site induction depending on the nature of their visit.
Deliveries and collections are managed with designated loading areas and traffic management procedures.



Training and Compliance

Our team are trained on safe chemical handling and emergency response.

We conduct periodic safety audits and reviews to ensure continued compliance with UK legislation and best practice.
